- Burglary residential where home was unlocked and someone just walked in. Also unsecured garages and some commercial
- Theft from Motor Vehicle more license plates stolen. Note: anti-theft screws are free and available from District 3 Station, University and I-25
- Theft of motor vehicles 3 unlocked with keys inside. 1 with loaded gun inside
 car was retrieved but gun was not.
- Theft tools and bikes that had been left out, unsecured.

- would like to be able to promote the Table so that more people are aware of where it is and what they provide as they have become an important partner on the river front.
- would like to know the pragmatic part of this project including what is the timeline and budget? No timeline yet and budget may start in the low 5 figures range.
