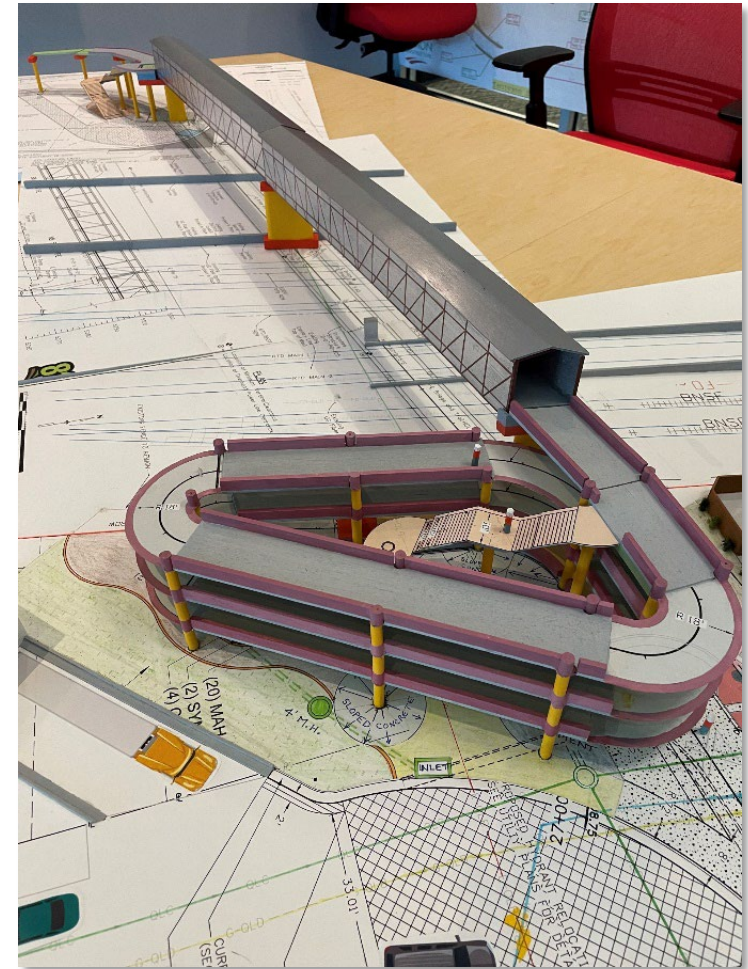

2025 Active Construction Projects

- **West Jewell Avenue Bicycle and Pedestrian Bridge**
- **Broadway and I-25 Safety Improvements**
- **Alameda Underpass**
- **S. Platte River Trail Improvements – Virginia to Bayaud St**

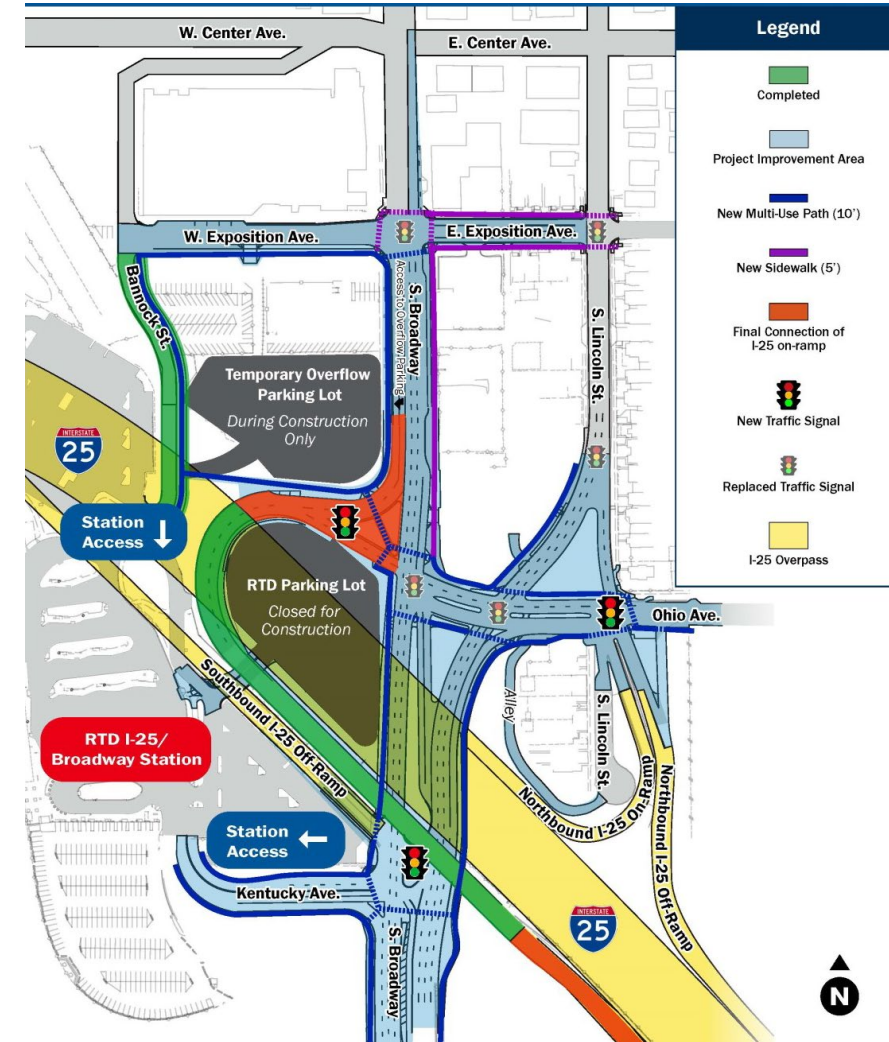
West Jewell Ave Bike & Pedestrian Bridge

- Technically project is underway with bridge procurement that began in Q3 2024
- Bridge and steel are long-lead items, they require several months for procurement, design, sign-off and off-site construction before being shipped and installed
- Activity on site will begin in **June/July**
- Project is expected to be substantially complete in Spring 2027



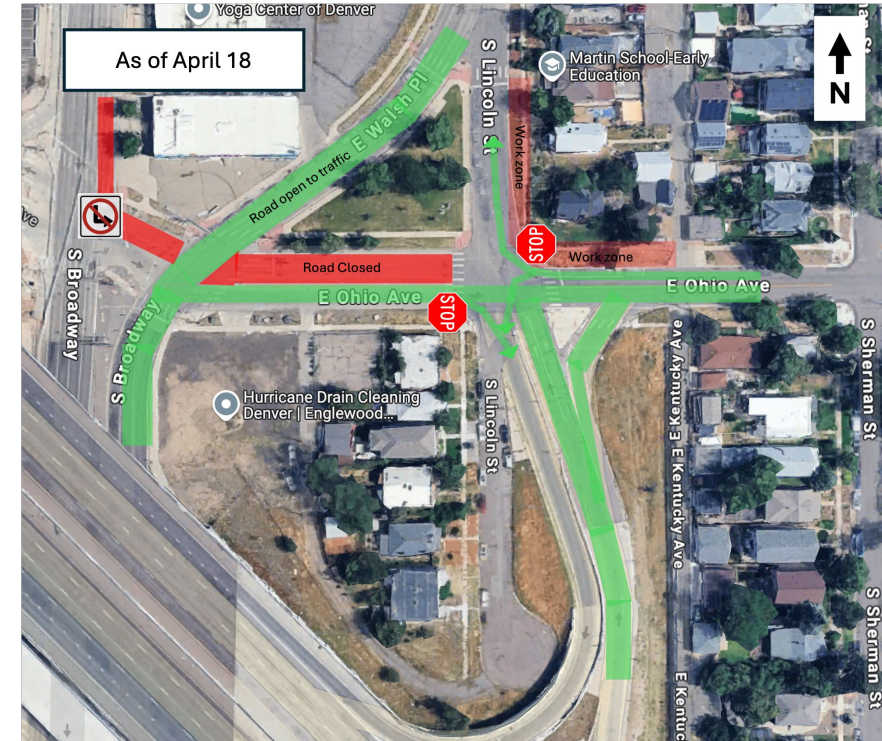
Broadway & I-25 Safety Improvements

- Travel lanes on Broadway within the project limits are reduced to two lanes in each direction and will remain this way through summer of 2025
- On-going project thru Spring 2026



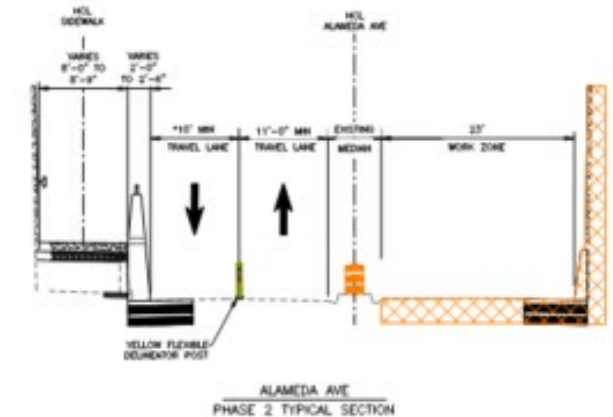
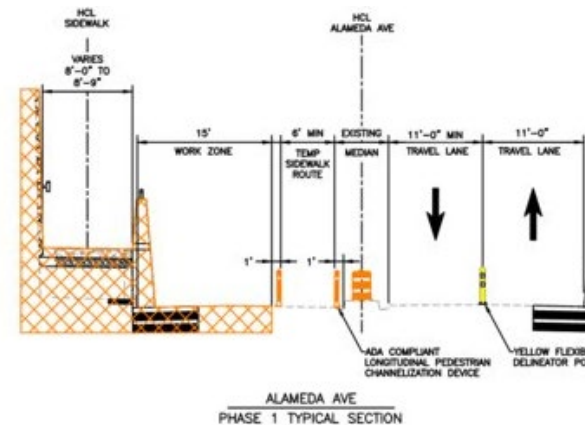
Broadway & I-25 Safety Improvements

- Crews poured concrete near the southbound Broadway off-ramp and on northbound Broadway
- Continue improvements at the northeast corner of Ohio and Lincoln
- Poured sidewalks for the future Denver Tramway Trolley Line interpretative mitigation area near Bannock



Alameda Underpass

- Now thru Spring 2026
- Traffic Control limits span from east of S. Cherokee Street to W. Santa Fe Drive
- Pedestrian and Vehicular access maintained during construction
- Vehicular traffic open to one lane each direction. Alternative detour route via Mississippi Ave is also provided



S Platte River Trail Improvements – Virginia to Bayaud

- Construction is underway
- Concrete sidewalks are being poured
- West Virginia Ave. and S. Jason Street intersection will be closed until the end of April 2025
- Project completion is Summer 2026

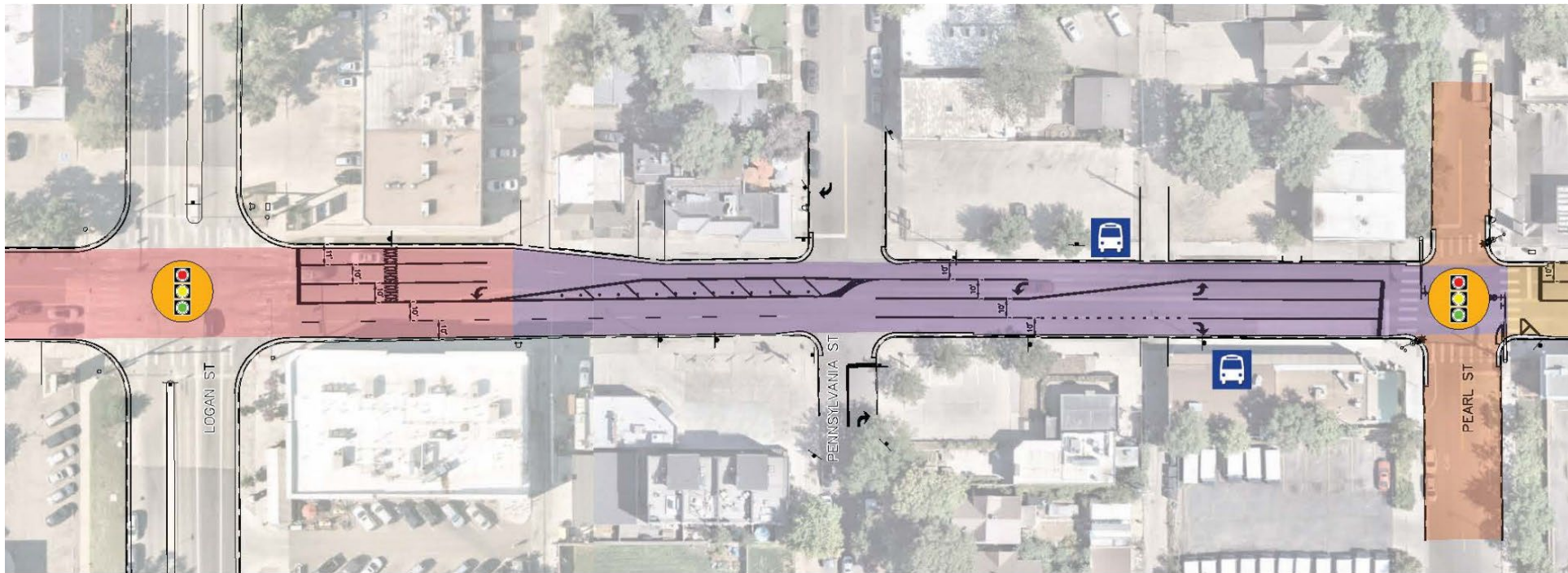

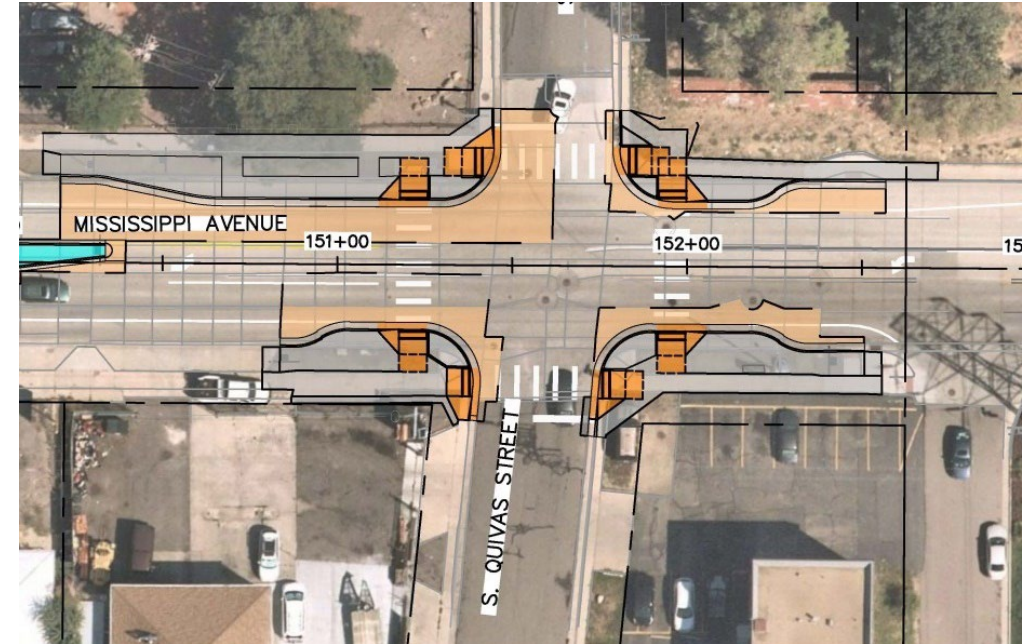
Alameda Lane Repurposing

- Bidding in Q2 2025 – Construction later in 2025
- Construction will begin this summer and last approximately 4 months (rolling work west to east)



Mississippi Ave Vision Zero

- Design complete
- Project will be bid in the few weeks
- Construction to begin in Summer/Fall 2025
- Project will be coordinated with Goldrick Elementary prior to start of construction



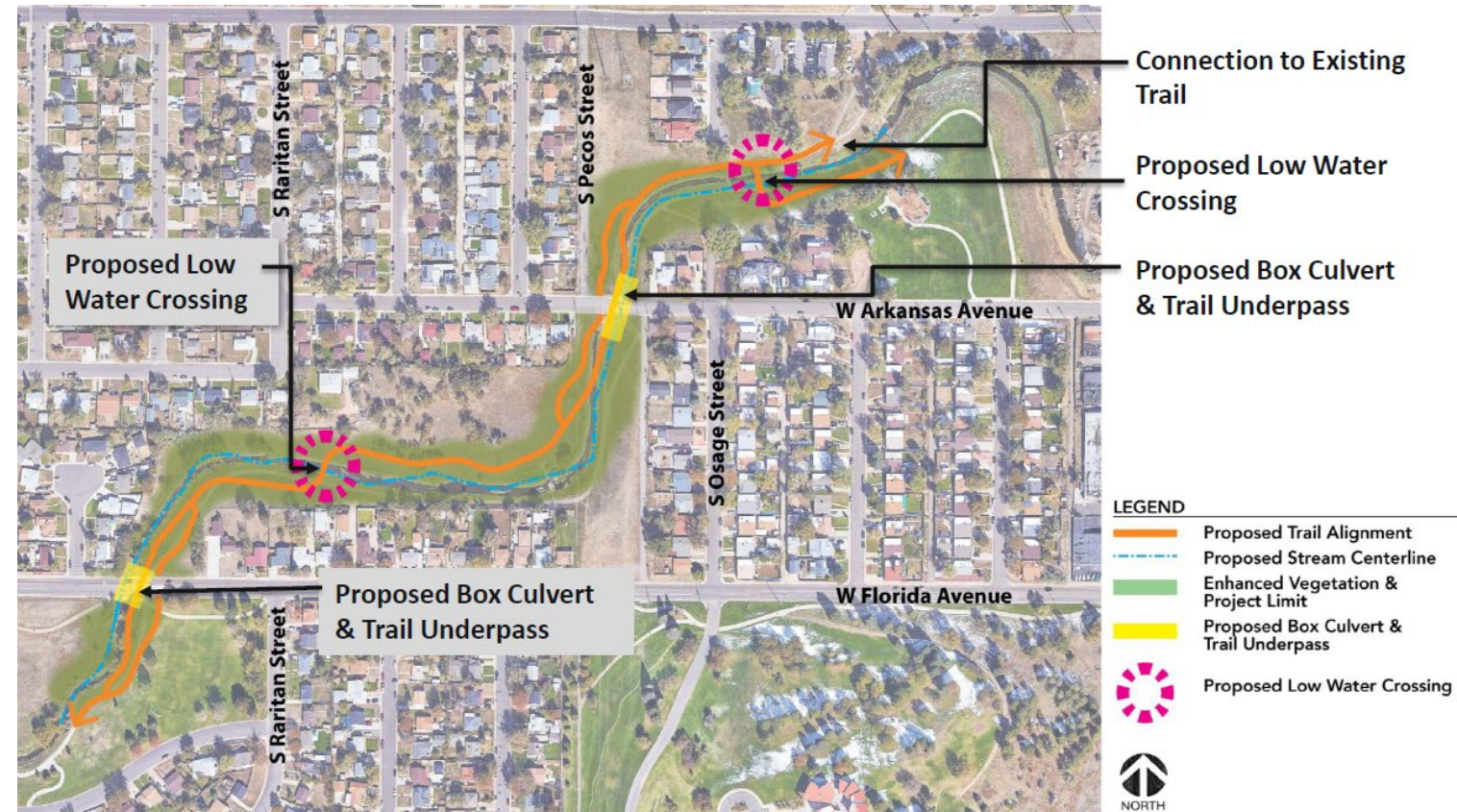
Iowa Underpass

- Design is complete
- Coordinating licensing agreements with railroads for work under the bridge
- Once agreements are in-place the project will be bid for construction



Sanderson Gulch – Florida Ave to Arkansas Ave

- In design – 90% in July
- Replace failing grouted riprap drop structure and the undersized culverts
- Convey the 100-year flood
- Upgrade the trail and under crossings to meet current DPR standards



2025 Active Planning Projects

Southwest Neighborhood Planning Initiative

- Long-term community vision for the neighborhoods of Athmar Park, Mar Lee, Overland, Ruby Hill and Westwood
- First Draft is ready for review and may be downloaded on the project website
- Southwest NPI open house
 - **Saturday, April 26 | 10 am to noon**
 - Goldrick Elementary School



Mississippi Ave. over S. Platte River Bridge Replacement Project

- Wider sidewalks on the bridge
- Improvements to S. Platte River Trail under the bridge
- Existing south connection from the bridge to the trail will be upgraded to current Denver Parks and ADA standards including meeting ADA criteria
- New connection from the bridge to the trail on the north side of the bridge
